CONCEPT OF THE SEMINAR

The transgender community is among the most vulnerable marginalized communities that continues to face persistent poverty, poor health outcomes and social exclusion: even by their own family and society. This situation persists in almost all the countries with slight differences. Due to the non-acceptance of cultural gender identity associated with biological sex, they have been looked down upon. The family does not accept them too, because of which they have to face exclusion. For decades, neither the gender-differential identity of this community was recognized by the government nor their fundamental human rights were protected as citizens. Lack of legal recognition as a third gender has been a significant barrier that often prevents them from exercising civil rights with their desired gender identity. In 2014, while recognizing the third gender, the Supreme Court gave several essential guidelines to the Central and the State Governments. Following the guidelines of the Supreme Court, the Central Government passed The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act- 2019 for the all-round development of transgender persons. But despite this, this community is still marginalized. They have not been able to get social and provisional recognition. Even after getting the constitutional right, it is still looked down upon socially. Meanwhile, the media has misrepresented, ignored, and sometimes portrayed

them as anti-religious, antisocial and harmful. This seminar will be fruitful for a spontaneous group discussion to produce ideas and ways of solving problems of the third gender in relation with media and society.
